<u>Insurance</u> Contractor shall not commence work under this contract until satisfactory evidence has been provided to UA that Contractor can cover the requirements set forth in this provision with regard to Contractor and subcontractors when engaged in any work performed under this Agreement.

Indemnification and Hold Harmless Agreement

Contractor shall indemnify, save harmless and defend the University of Alaska, its Board of Regents, officers, agents, and employees from all liability, including costs and expenses, for all actions or claims resulting from injuries or damages sustained by any person or property arising directly or indirectly as a result of any error, omission, or negligent or wrongful act of the contractor, subcontractor, or anyone directly or indirectly employed by them in the performance of this Agreement.

All actions or claims including costs and expenses resulting from injuries or damages sustained by any person or property arising directly or indirectly from Contractor's performance of this Agreement which are caused by the joint negligence of the University and Contractor shall be apportioned on a comparative fault basis; however, any such joint negligence on the part of the University must be a direct result of active involvement by the University.
